Highly experienced in performing easier catheterizations through the wrist

Our expert team performs cardiac catheterizations through the wrist. More than a million cardiac catheterizations are performed every year in the U.S. to detect problems and clear blockages in the heart and blood vessels. Traditionally, this procedure could be done only through a leg artery, which can be time-consuming and uncomfortable for patients.

However, using more complex techniques and the latest technology, the procedure can be safely performed through the wrists. This procedure is commonly used in Europe and Asia and helps reduce time, pain, and complications for patients but is technically more complex for physicians.

Our interventional cardiologists have advanced training and expertise in this area and have a high success rate performing catheterizations using either method. In fact, we have more than ten years of experience performing this procedure through an artery in the wrist rather than the leg and more than 80% of our catheterizations are now done using this approach.
